Objective: The Fund seeks long-term growth through capital appreciation.

The Fund invests in companies of any size and favors smaller-sized companies with market capitalization equal to or less than the largest company in the Russell 2000® Index and seeks companies with perceived leadership positions and competitive advantages in niche markets. The portfolio is diversified across industry sectors and focuses on companies that do not receive significant coverage from other institutional investors.

Portfolio Management:

The Fund portfolio is managed by a veteran investment team with 82 years collective investment experience and has been defining investment opportunities together at Emerald since 1994. The team maintains a disciplined focus to avoid style drift. As a result of an on-going comprehensive risk assessment process the team seeks to control volatility by diversifying the Fund's portfolio among subgroups within each industry sector and seeks to minimize risk by unequally weighting the percentage ownership of companies held.

Emerald Mutual Fund Advisers Trust ("Emerald" or the "Adviser") has agreed contractually to waive a portion of its fees and reimburse other expenses in amounts necessary to limit the Fund's operating expenses (exclusive of Acquired Fund Fees and Expenses, brokerage expenses, interest expenses, taxes, and extraordinary expense) for Class A, Class C, Institutional and Investor Class shares to an annual rate (as a percentage of the Fund's average daily net assets) of 1.29%, 1.94%, 0.99% and 1.34%, respectively. This agreement ("The Expense Agreement") is in effect until August 31, 2017. The Adviser will be permitted to recover, on a class-by-class basis, expenses it has borne through the Expense Agreement to the extent that the Fund's expenses in later periods fall below the expense cap in effect at the time of waiver or reimbursement. The Fund will not be obligated to pay any such deferred fees and expenses more than three years after the year(s) in which the fees and expenses were incurred. The Adviser may not discontinue this waiver prior to August 31, 2017, without the approval of the Fund's Board of Trustees.
